Introduction:

What is justification?

(Romans 5:18, II Corinthians 5:21)

1. We have peace with God. (Romans 5:1)

It is through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 4:25)

1.1 Relationship between man and God under the Law

The wrath of God was upon us. (Romans 1:18)

Something has to happen with respect to the wrath of God. (Romans 3:24-26)

1.2 The natural man is at enmity with God

(Romans 8:7, Ephesians 2:3, Ephesians 4:18)

Justification removed all these obstacles → entire new relationship

1.3 Do we lose our Peace with God when we fall? (Romans 8:1-2)

2. We are standing in Grace. (Romans 5:1)

2.1 'Gained access' by Faith through Christ Jesus

– our mediator, our great high priest.

2.2 What is this Grace in which we stand?

It is our new position, new status to receive all spiritual blessings. (II Peter 1:3)

2.3 We now stand firmly

It means entry and continuance.

It means security and stability. (John 10:28)

3. We rejoice in the Hope of the Glory of God. (Romans 5:2)

Glory of God means

“the invisible qualities, character or attribute of God displayed in a visible (Knowable) way.

Jesus reveals the Glory of God. (John 1:14)

3.1 The Object of our redemption is to see the Glory of God.

John 17:24

Revelation 5:12

3.2 We ourselves shall be Glorified. (I Corinthians 15:43)

3.3 We are being changed from Glory to Glory. (II Corinthians 3:18)

Conclusion:

Our Hope is based on the promise of God.

The Object of our hope is the Glory of God.

(Mark 13:26, Colossians 3:4)
