Introduction

“stand” 4x in vv 11, 13, 14

To be victorious over the powers of evil, we have to put on the armor of God: the belt, breastplate, shoes, (shield, helmet and sword).

1. The Belt Of Truth

“Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist...” (v14).

- a. Truth as Revealed in the Scriptures.
- b. Truth as “Sincerity” or “Integrity.”

2. The Breastplate Of Righteousness

“Stand firm then,... having put on the breastplate of righteousness.” (v14).

- a. Righteousness as God’s Gift
- b. Righteousness as in Right Living

3. The Shoes Of The Gospel Of Peace

“and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.”

- a. Firmness from the Gospel of Peace
- b. Readiness to Proclaim the Gospel of Peace
