INTRODUCTION

WORSHIP:

Definition of Worship

1. **Place of worship** –

- i. Attitude of Worship, not location (John 4:21)
- ii. “Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:19)

2. **Act of worship** – John 4:22-24

- i. Worship the true God (John 1:14, 14:6-7)

“Strong affections for God, rooted in and shaped by the truth of Scripture – this is the bone and marrow of Biblical worship.” John Piper.

- ii. Worship from the heart (Genesis 22)

Obedience is an outward sign of the heart that loves God and put God above all else.

- iii. Worship with all of our life

Everything that we do must flow out of a heart that loves God.

Worship with everything that we have.

‘Whole life worship’ – Hebrews 13:15-16
