The big idea:

We are all sinners, saved by grace through faith in Jesus, to do good works.

God is the creator of the universe, and He created us in His image.

1. We all have sinned and are unable to save ourselves

- Fall of Man
- Original sin
- Total depravity

2. Grace is given by God to bring us to repentance and to restore our relationship with God

- Preventive grace
- Convincing grace
- Atonement
- Justification

3. Our human response is having faith in Jesus, and to do good works in obedience to Him and to become like Jesus

- Regenerative grace
- Sanctification
